

CAREER COUNSELING AND CAREER COURSES: PROCESS, IMPACT AND OUTCOMES

The process of choosing a major, career or pursuit of a graduate degree is a fundamentally stressful and important decision for many college students. Some students who experience difficulty finding a suitable career direction ultimately drop out of college. University Grant Commission across the country have noticed this trend and developed career-oriented programming/services to address these needs. Universities and colleges have looked towards career services as a way of improving both satisfaction with and utility of a student's educational experience. The career decision-making process highlights the ways in which individuals choose a career trajectory; moving from a state of confusion to decision. As students navigate the decision-making process, it is important that they have certain information, including knowledge about themselves, the world of work, barriers that may exist, career paths and requirements of occupations. 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
