### **NOTIFICATION**

We are passing through a very difficult times due to the outbreak of COVID 19 Pandemic and the destruction caused by the recent super cyclone. In this period of crisis, the University is deeply concerned with the future of our students studying in both our regular and distant modes. The students are advised not to worry. The University is engaged in working out the following appropriate measures to safeguard their interest:

1. To ensure the safety and security of the students, faculties and staffs and also to resume all academic activities including examinations.
2. To conduct the examinations and publish the results.

As to the holding of the end semester and annual examinations and all other examinations including the PG examinations scheduled to be held in June-July 2020, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the mode, schedule and detailed guidelines of all such examinations shall be notified on the official website of the university, (<http://vidyasagar.ac.in/>) in due course of time, in compliance with the statutory directions/advisories issued by Govt. Agencies and UGC from time to time. Therefore, all concerned are advised to frequently visit the official website of the university for updates / notifications related to the examination mode/schedule/or guidelines. Only that information available on the university website of should be trusted to be authentic.

Similarly, students who already appeared in the examinations or examinations which could not be fully completed due to the lockdown and are either awaiting their results or waiting for notification regarding fresh dates for their remaining examinations are also advised to rely on the University website for all updates and NOT to pay heed to rumors or hearsay.

The University is likely to announce the detailed schedule and/or decision relating to all such matters by 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2020.

The examination department also notifies that the examinations (Conventional/Alternative modes) will be planned in such a way that not a single student's career is adversely affected by this unprecedented crisis. The mode of all examinations will be decided by the University by giving topmost priority to the best interest of the students and their safety. All students including those pursuing PG Courses in the distance mode, are advised to continue their studies from home.
